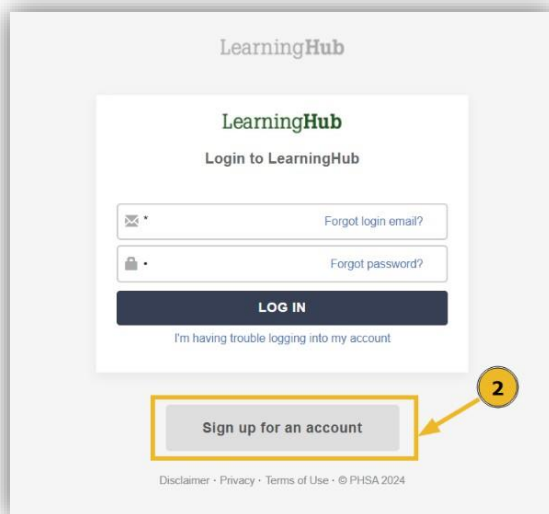

What best describes your role with Provincial Health Services Authority?

 Provincial Health Services Authority

BC Health Organization or HEABC Employee
All Employees working directly under a BC health organization, including nurses and Allied Health professionals.
A direct Employee ID under the specified organization is required.
HEABC: All HEABC employees, including temporary and contract staff.

Affiliate/Contractor
Employees of any group with an existing legal partnership or affiliate agreement with a BC health authority including but not limited to contractors.
HEABC: Individuals who work for an HEABC affiliate member organization or the Ministry of Health.

Medical Staff
BC Health Organization active privileged medical staff without a health organization employee ID. (e.g. physicians, dentists, midwives, etc.)
Nurse practitioners are advised to select the employee role if they have a health organization employee number.

Student
A student preparing for or participating in a placement (clinical or otherwise) within a BC health organization.

Volunteer
Individuals providing volunteer services in a health care setting in BC.

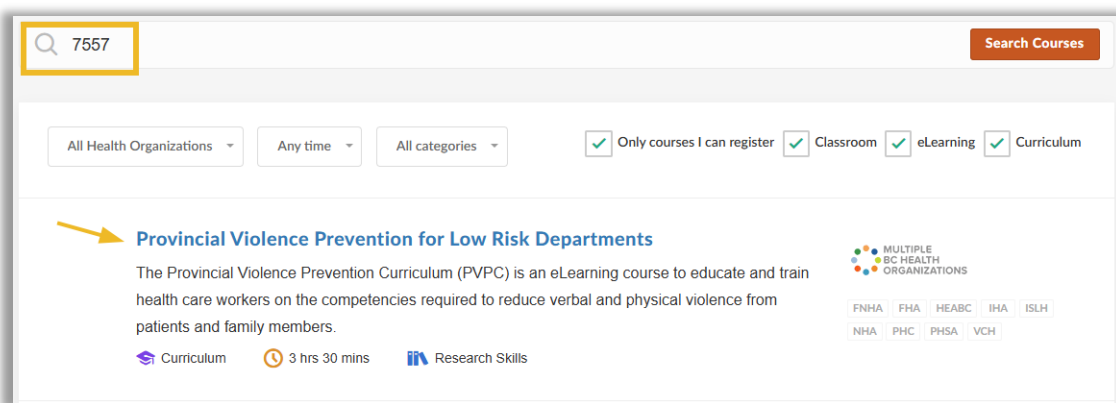

Each medical clinic staff member must create an individual account to track course progress and completion. Once your Learning Hub account is created, search for the following courses:

Violence Prevention eLearning Courses

Course code #7557: Provincial Violence Prevention Curriculum (PVPC) for Low Risk Departments (210 minutes in total). This curriculum includes eight eLearning courses and is designed for all healthcare workers in low-risk workplaces, including medical clinic staff. Participants receive a certificate of completion upon completing all courses.



Course code #35688: Provincial Violence Prevention Curriculum (PVPC) for Physicians eLearning course (90 minutes in total). This course is designed for medical staff, including physicians, nurse practitioners and medical residents. It is certified by UBC CPD, and medical staff can earn 1.5 Mainpro+ credits for CPD.
